The Flag of Oklahoma was designed by Louise Fluke and adopted in 1925. The flag of the State of Oklahoma consists of a traditional Osage Nation buffalo-skin shield with seven eagle feathers on a Choctaw sky blue field.

The University of Tulsa is located in Tulsa, Oklahoma. TU was founded in 1894 and is home to over 4,000 students.



Botanical Garden is a zoo and botanical garden located in Oklahoma City's Adventure District in northeast Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The zoo covers 119 acres and is home to more than 1,900 animals.









The entertainment district, Bricktown, is located in downtown Oklahoma City. Founded just days after the Land Run of 1889, Bricktown gained several improvements after the 1993 MAPS public facility enhancement project passed and is now home to a canal with Water Taxi boats, a baseball stadium, retail shops, restaurants, museums and galleries.



Gathering Place was voted USA Today's Best New Attraction of 2019. The park covers 66 acres and it is centered on the east bank of the Arkansas River south of Downtown Tulsa.

The Myriad Botanical Gardens is located in downtown Oklahoma City. The Gardens' primary feature is the Crystal Bridge Tropical Conservatory - a living plant museum featuring towering palm trees, tropical plants and flowers, waterfalls, and exotic animals.
